WORK SAFELY AT HEIGHTS ***(RIIWHS204D)***

This nationally recognised unit is designed to provide participants currently working or intending to work at heights, with the knowledge and skills to safely work in any height situation, primarily being aimed at general construction, maintenance, mining, large factories or other work situations, conducted more than two meters from the ground.



SPOTTERS COURSE

(22325VIC – Course in Workplace Spotting for Service Assets)

This course will enable participants to clearly understand the role of the Spotter as the safety observer to warn mobile plant operators and crane drivers in the proximity of overhead powerlines and underground assets inclusive of communications, water, gas, sewerage and power.



This course is recognised by Energy Safe Victoria (ESV) and the Victorian WorkSafe Authority, as meeting the requirement under Victorian Regulations for Plant Operations near overhead powerlines and underground assets.

ENTER AND WORK IN CONFINED SPACES ***(RIIWHS202D)***

A confined space may be an area of restricted entry and exit may have an atmosphere which contains potentially harmful levels of a contaminant, unsafe levels of oxygen or may cause engulfment.

This nationally recognised unit covers entering and working in confined spaces in resources and infrastructure industries. The course includes planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces, entry and working in confined spaces, exiting confined spaces and cleaning up.

TRAFFIC CONTROL / MANAGEMENT

Control Traffic with Stop-Slow Bat (RIIWHS205D)

Implement Traffic Management Plan (RIIWHS302D)

These two nationally recognised units include implementing traffic management plans for not only public, but private roads as well as parking areas, and restricted access construction sites. The course also sets out requirements and duties of traffic controllers to safely manage traffic using stop/slow bats. This provides ideal knowledge and skills for the protection of construction sites, workers and the general public.

Star Training and Assessing conducts one-day courses combining both Units of Competency and half day refresher courses (industry recommends every 3 years).



WHITE CARD / CONSTRUCTION INDUCTION CARD

Prepare to Work Safely in the Construction Industry (CPCCWHS1001)

This nationally recognised unit is designed to comply with WorkSafe Victoria and Occupational Health and Safety requirements and is aimed to provide participants with the essential knowledge and skills to work in a range of construction sites in Australia.

The Construction Induction Card (White Card) is compulsory for anyone working on a construction site in Australia and is issued by WorkSafe Victoria.

IDENTIFY LOCATE AND PROTECT UNDERGROUND SERVICES (RIICCM202D)



This nationally recognised unit is appropriate for those working in operational roles where they are required to identify, locate and protect underground services. This unit provides participant's with the skills and knowledge required to identify, locate and protect underground services in the Civil Construction and Utilities Industries.

DEMONSTRATE FIRST ATTACK FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT (CPPFES2005)

This nationally recognised unit is appropriate for those working in any roll in any industry. Demonstrate First Attack Firefighting equipment gives candidates the necessary skills and knowledge to safely and confidently use portable fire extinguishers, fire hose reels and fire blankets to extinguish a small fire.



OPERATE AS PART OF AN EMERGENCY CONTROL ORGANISATION (PUAWER005B)

This nationally recognised unit covers the competency required to implement the emergency response specified in the workplace emergency procedures or specified by a person at a higher level in the emergency control organisation.

People who undertake this work will be working within the command, control and coordinate structure of the emergency control organisation.

This unit has been developed to cover the broad range of emergencies and workplaces as considered in Australian Standard 3745-2010.

FIRST AID AND CPR

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (HLTAID001)

Provide Basic Emergency Life Support (HLTAID002)

Provide First Aid (HLTAID003)



Star Training and Assessing delivers two levels of First Aid (Level 1, Level 2 (Senior First Aid) and CPR.

First Aiders undertake the initial treatment of people suffering injury and illness at work. The first few minutes are crucial, so it's important that there are first aid facilities and trained first aiders in the workplace to ensure that immediate help is available.



Employers have a legal requirement to assess their first aid needs, as each workplace varies in size and layout as well as in regards to hazards and risks.

HLTAID003 - Provide First Aid

This nationally recognised unit incorporates HLTAID001 'Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation' and HLTAID002 'Provide Basic Emergency Life Support' and is designed to provide participants with the essential knowledge and skills to respond and support a person experiencing illness or injury until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

HLTAID002 - Provide Basic Emergency Life Support

This nationally recognised unit is suitable for those wishing to have the skills and knowledge to perform emergency first aid procedures in the first few minutes after a life-threatening incident. The course is recommended to those who are required to obtain only a basic level of first aid training as part of their job.

HLTAID001 - Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

This nationally recognised unit is designed to provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.

HIGH RISK WORK LICENCES

LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK (TLILIC0003)

Star Training & Assessing is WorkSafe accredited to deliver forklift training and assessment in VIC, WA and QLD. The course is aligned with industry requirements and is designed to provide students with the opportunity to experience a broad range of workplace situations. The length of the course varies and is suitable for experienced operators, as well as those with limited or no forklift operating experience.



LICENCE TO OPERATE AN ORDER PICKING FORKLIFT TRUCK (TLILIC0004)

Star Training & Assessing is WorkSafe accredited to deliver the LO Forklift Licence, also known as the Order Picker or Stock Picker forklift licence in VIC, WA and QLD. An LO Forklift Licence will allow you to operate an LO (8C high reach) type forklift; in compliance with Australian Government high-risk work guidelines and regulations.



LICENCE TO OPERATE A BOOM-TYPE ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM (boom length 11metres or more) (TLILIC0005)

Star Training & Assessing is WorkSafe accredited to deliver EWP training and assessment in VIC, WA and QLD. This nationally recognised unit of competency is designed to provide students with the ability to operate an elevated work platform (EWP) safely and arm them with the knowledge and skills required to obtain a 'National High Risk Work License, Class 'WP'. The national guidelines stipulate a WP licence is required for the use of all types of elevated work platforms with a boom reach of 11 metres and above.



Star Training and Assessing also conducts training and assessment on Elevated Work Platforms (RIIHAN301E – Operate Elevated Work Platforms) which do not require a WorkSafe High Risk Work Licence.
